Spotlight on Safeguarding

Operation Encompass

Our school participates in a national scheme called 'Operation Encompass', which is a partnership between West Midlands Police and schools.

One of the principles of Operation Encompass is that all incidents of domestic abuse are shared with schools, not just those where an offence can be identified.

This system has been established to help schools provide inhouse support to children who have been present at, exposed to or involved in any domestic abuse incident.

We know that children can be significantly harmed physically and/or emotionally during these situations and that it negatively affects their learning and behaviour. Therefore, as part of the Operation Encompass procedure, and to help mitigate the resulting negative impact, the school receives an email the day after a child has been witness to or involved in any reported domestic abuse incident. We are then able to use this information to provide the right support to any child and their family as and when it is needed.

If this is an issue that affects you and your family, and you need help, advice or support please see one of the DSLs at Paget and we will be there to support you.
